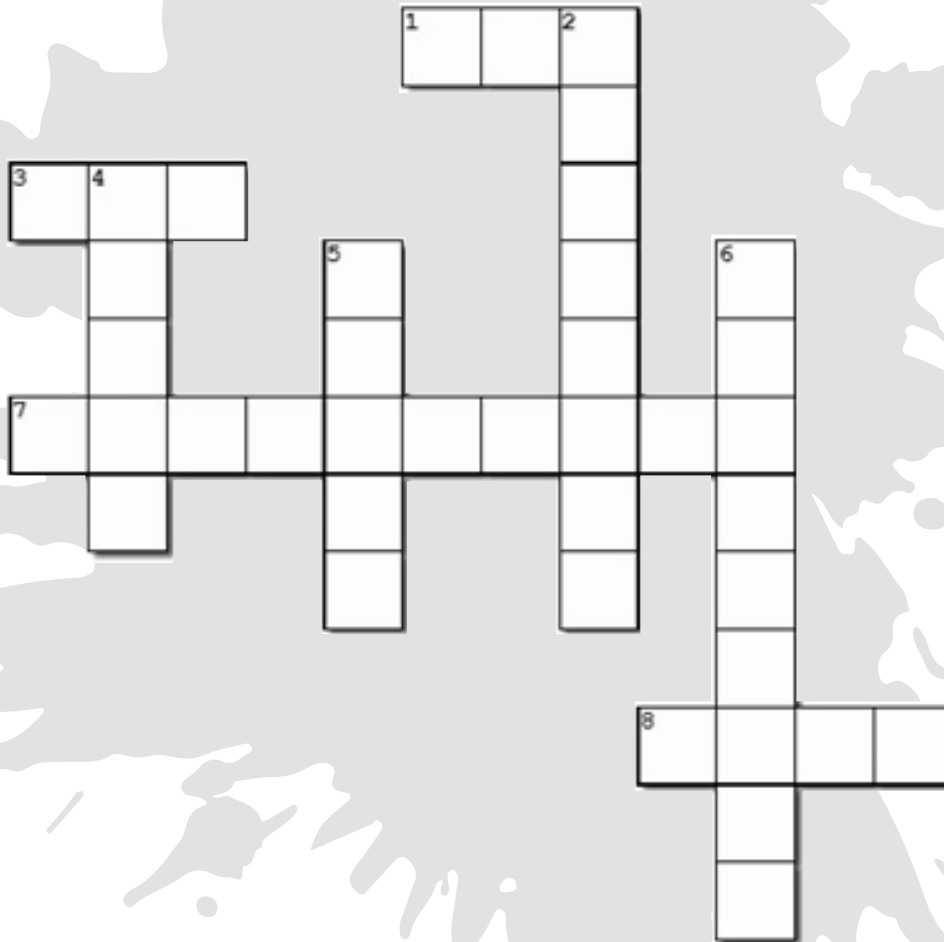

1 This wall is located in the courtyard of a primary public school in Sagunto, Valencia. It was created by Hyuro (1974-2020) in 2018 and talked about the current educational system in Spain.

- Why do you think the student is carrying the desk on his back? Where is he going?
- Are you motivated in class? Explain what was the most interesting activity developed in class this school year.
- Imagine that you were the teacher. What would you change from how you currently learn at school?

2 iHeart is a Canadian street artist based out of Vancouver, British Columbia. Using stencils, iHeart emphasizes the dark side of society's obsession with technology. By bringing these digital elements into the street, iHeart obscures the boundary between life on and offline.

- What's the impact of social media in your life?
- How could you help this little guy from being unhappy?
- Do you think there is too much addiction to FB, IG, TikTok among teenagers? Should they spend less time on the internet?

3 Blu began to experiment with paint rollers and telescopic sticks in Italy. Not only was his graffiti art much larger, but his art conveyed a much more dramatic appearance. He quickly began to create huge human figures that were often sarcastic in appearance and resembled comic and video game art.
